Patron/Guest Guidelines

Kids America will reopen on May 26, 2020 for patrons and guests and will be conducting activities as they are released by the Ohio Governor's office! The below information consists of site specific mandatory guidelines put forth by the Ohio Governor's office to be followed by all visitors to Kids America. For the safety of the children, patrons, guests, and KA staff and to comply with the state of Ohio Governor's office, please read and follow the below guidelines when visiting Kids America.

- Patrons/Guests must conduct a self-assessment before each visit and not enter the facility or participate in any outdoor activity if they are exhibiting symptoms or have been exposed to COVID-19
- Upon entry to the complex, sanitize your hands using the hand sanitizer between the entry and exit doors / for outdoor activities sanitize your hands using the hand sanitizer in the pavilion restrooms or concession stand area / hand sanitizer is available at the concession area, fitness room, aerobics room, and track
- Indoor visitors must verbally check-in with the front desk staff by giving your first and last name and wait until the staff confirms that you have been checked-in properly / outdoor visitors will verbally check-in with the presiding coach or sports director
- Visitor's need to provide their own sporting equipment when possible as only a selective amount of equipment will be made available by Kids America
- Social distancing of six feet will be adhered to unless drills and personal instruction require less separation or visitors are part of a family group
- Visitor's using the fitness room, aerobics room, or any other equipment must utilize the provided sanitizing spray to clean after use
- Visitor's who utilize the showers will report their use of the facilities to the front desk staff upon departure
- Visitor's may not use the 2nd level seating at this time
- Visitor's should bring their own water bottles as the water fountains are disabled with the exception of the water bottle filler because it is hands-free
- Before exiting the facility or when activities are complete, sanitize your hands and equipment

Kids America is continuing to remain true to our mission by providing the essential services and facilities necessary for the positive development and well-being of the Coshocton Community and surrounding areas.

Kids America staff have taken steps to ensure that our facility is a safe place for visitors to continue fulfilling their exercise and recreational needs. Daily cleaning of the facility is continuing with extra care given to the high traffic areas. Kids America also provides Purell hand soap in the restrooms and encourages regular hand washing before and after activities, after handling equipment, after restroom use, etc. Any visitor who is unwilling or unable to comply with the above guidelines or expanded guidelines through the Responsible Restart Ohio mandatory guidelines are at risk of being removed from the facility.
